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Civil Code § 798.11 – Compiled July, 2011

Our review of the annotated history reveals the following legislative history (every “c.” below represents a separate legislative bill):

§ 798.11

Prior History: None identified

Added: 1978, c. 1031 as CC § 798.7

Amended: 1980, c. 502 (renumbered § 798.10); 1981, c. 714 (renumbered § 798.11); 1982, c. 1397

Four bills affected this section. While this section was renumbered a few times, it appears to have retained its original language since 1978. In 1978, the language read as follows:

798.7. “Resident” is a tenant or other person who lawfully occupies a mobilehome.

In 1982, the term “tenant” was replaced by “homeowner”.

Tracing Statutory Language:
