Health and Safety Code § 1430 – Compiled April, 2011

Our review of the annotated history of this statute reveals the following legislative history (every “c.” below represents a separate legislative bill):

Added: 1973, c. 1057
Amended: 1982, c. 1455; 2004, c. 270

- **1982:** added subdivision designations to (a) and (c); added “or her” to (a) and added (b)
- **2004:** amended (a) by substituting “a” for “any”, “that” for “which”, “an action” for “Such actions”, “may” for “shall” and adding a comma after “corporations” and “members.” Amended (b) by adding “current or former” after “A” at the beginning of the sentence; substituting “facility” for “facilities”; and substituting “Code of Regulations, or any other right provided for by federal or state law or regulation” for “Administrative Code” at the end of the first sentence.

Tracing Statutory Language:

- Research fees can be minimized by ordering only the bills that affected specific subdivisions or phrases of interest to you.
- Changes to statutes can sometimes be determined by the annotations provided by Deering’s, Westlaw, and Lexis.
- **If annotations are not available, one strategy** is to look at each chaptered law noted above to observe the changes. **Another strategy** is to retain us to *trace* your language and report our findings back to you.
