



LEGISLATIVE INTENT SERVICE, INC.

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Labor Code § 1198 – Compiled February 2011

Our review of the annotated history reveals the following legislative history (every “c.” below represents a separate legislative bill):

§ 1198: (3 bills)

Prior History: Former uncodified § 11a, added 1927, c. 248, amending the 1913 (c. 324) Act

Current: added 1937 Codification of Labor Code; amended 1973, c. 1007

Please Note: *Only the 1927 bill enacting the original language is substantive.* The 1937 codification is nonsubstantive and the 1973 amendment merely made grammatical corrections, such as substituting “employees” in the place of “women and minors” throughout the statute.

Tracing Statutory Language:

- Research fees can be minimized by ordering only the bills that affected specific subdivisions or phrases of interest to you.
